## Tournament Information

Sheridan College would like to welcome you to Sheridan, Wyoming for the 2010 Region IX Men's Basketball Tournament. We hope your stay is a good one and that you enjoy your visit to our community. Please read closely the following tournament information:

1. All information can be seen on the 2010 Region IX Men's Tournament website at [www.scgenerals.com/regionix](http://www.scgenerals.com/regionix). (Site is still under construction, but will be operational soon).
2. Please park all buses in the lot on the North side of the Bruce Hoffman Golden Dome. If drivers would park on the east end of the lot, it would be appreciated.
3. All games can be viewed online live at [www.scgenerals.com/regionix](http://www.scgenerals.com/regionix)
4. Locker rooms will be assigned each day of the tournament. A greeter will meet you at the entrance with assignment and key.
5. Just a reminder: Top team will be home and wear white. Home team's bench will be the bench located in the north-east section of the gym (the bench furthest away from the main entrance to the building). \*\*\*Exception = Host team will always be home & wear white\*\*\*
6. Statistics: Sheridan College will provide statistics throughout the tournament. Statistics will be made available to each coach at half time and at the end of each game. Copies will also be made available to the hospitality room shortly following the end of each game.
7. Please pay close attention to the attached practice schedule.

  - Reminder:
    - The only practices which may be held on the tournament floor prior to the beginning of the tournament are the 30 minute practice rounds assigned on your school's first day of the tournament. Remember these assigned times may not be exchanged, swapped, or filled by another team because a team did not want to use their slot.
  - Sheridan College does not have an auxiliary gym, so the only practices offered will be the 30 minute slots on the day of your game
8. Warm-up and Practice Balls: Warm-up balls will be provided for each team. Balls will be available in the main gym for practice. ***Please do not remove any practice balls from the facility!***

9. Each team must make their own hotel reservations.
  - o ***Please see attached hotel information*** for rates and numbers of participating hotels in Sheridan.
10. Currently, athletic training services & supplies will not be provided to all teams. Sheridan College unfortunately does not have an athletic trainer on staff. However, teams will have access to the training room on at the east end of the Dome. ***There will be a physical therapist available at times throughout the tournament from Sheridan Physical Therapy and emergency services are possible through Sheridan Orthopedic. \*\*Note – we are attempting to contract services with a certified trainer; please check back as we near the tourney\*\****
11. Medical Information: Memorial Hospital is located at 1401 West 5<sup>th</sup> Street, 307-672-1000, or Emergency Room is 307-672-1100.
12. A video taping area will be provided. Sheridan College will provide services to videotape each game. Video of your game will be available for ***\$15/game*** (this includes a DVD) or ***\$10/game*** (you supply the DVD). Someone will contact you prior to your game each night to make arrangements.
13. Game Warm-Ups: Teams may not take the playing floor more than 30 minutes prior to your game time. Note: If games run over scheduled time, the teams playing the next game will still receive 20 minutes of warm-up time.
14. Players are not to shoot around on the playing floor during half-times of games.
15. Towels: Sheridan College will supply bench towels for each game. ***Shower and/or locker room towels will not be provided!***
16. Hospitality Room: A hospitality room will be provided throughout the tournament. Passes for coaches will be provided in tournament packets.
17. Radio: Radio broadcast hook-ups will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please have them call (307 674 6446 x 4000) or email [ssmiley@sheridan.edu](mailto:ssmiley@sheridan.edu) to arrange a space.
18. Officials: Independent official coordinator Phil Gates has assigned all officials for the tournament.
19. Admission Prices = \$5 adults per session, \$3 for students / seniors per session  
There will be 2 sessions per day (Friday, Saturday, Sunday)  
Tournament Pass = \$25 (access to all sessions throughout the tournament)
