

## Sheridan College Generals Athletic Hall of Fame and Distinction

Nominations are open for the Class of 2016-2017 Generals Athletics Hall of Fame and Distinction. Nominations are open to any former General student-athlete, coach or person closely connected to the Generals athletic program who meet the following criteria:

- Have made a “significant contribution” to a Generals Athletics program OR have made a significant contribution via Sheridan College Athletics to business, education, coaching, or some other aspect of society.
- Individuals may be nominated in any of the following categories for sport programs running longer than 10 years:
  - Student-Athlete
  - Team
  - Coach
  - Athletic Director
  - Other person closely connected to the General Athletics program
  - Honor and Distinction
- Each nominee must have been out of the Generals athletic program for at least ten years.
- Athlete candidates are not required to have a college degree, but must have completed two years of athletic eligibility.
- Coaches must have coached at Sheridan College for a minimum of 5 years and may be currently coaching or retired.
- No more than five will be inducted per year. Recommendations include three athletes, one coach and one contributor, though this may vary.

The Generals Athletics Hall of Fame and Distinction recognition will be presented at the second to last home scheduled event of the nominees sport. Dates and times will be communicated to nominees.

The Athletic Director will compile a list of nominees to be voted on by the Generals Hall of Fame selection committee, then approved by the Athletic Director, and finally approved by the President.
